Shultz: Nicaragua 'rotten apple'

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Secretary of State George Shultz on Sunday labeled Nicaragua a "rotten apple in the barrel" of emerging Central American democracies.

Describing the Central American mission he will embark upon late this month, Shultz said: "I'm going to carry the U.S. message of what our objectives are, and our program and ideas for getting there."

On NBC's Meet the Press, he said he thought the Reagan administration's doctrine of pushing democracy in the region had been mostly successful.

But when asked to name his No. 1 foreign policy disappointment, Shultz pointed to the continuing rule of Nicaragua by the Marxist Sandinista government.

"In spite of the fact that we've made great strides there [in Central America]... the fact is we still have this bad, rotten apple in the barrel in the form of Nicaragua," he said.
